- Staffing a booth at a community event (1-3 times per year)
- Share brochures and other FRC-SC information in the community and/or on social media
- Assist with set-up of a class and check-in participants
- Co-plan a family-centered class
- Co-facilitate a family-centered class.
- Pick up and deliver pre-ordered food for a Parent Café
- Receive training and act as a Table Host at a Parent Café
- Write or record a testimonial describing your experience with the FRC-SC
- Assist at one of our playgroups or seasonal events.
