our programming


The Family Resource Center was established in 1997 as a nonprofit organization and is dedicated to supporting young children, their families, and adults through its two strengthsbased, preventive programs:

Parents as Teachers is a voluntary, strengths- and evidence-based home visiting program dedicated to supporting families in various ways. Certified parent educators provide in-home visits, a variety of parenting classes, and family-focused community activities throughout Sheboygan County to help parents and their children make the most of the important early years. The Parents as Teachers home visiting program provided by the Family Resource Center of Sheboygan County is recognized as a "Blue Ribbon Affiliate," meaning that we meet essential Parents as Teachers requirements and deliver the highest-quality services to children and families.

Home Visits Provide:

- Age-appropriate child development information and activities
- Regular screenings to identify potential development delays, health issues, and home safety concerns
- Postpartum depression screenings
- Parenting skills support
- Information about food and nutrition
- Community resource information

- Monthly family activities
- Parenting classes

Literacy Council helps adults who want to read, write, and speak English better in order to achieve their goals for work, education, family life, and community involvement. Our caring, patient volunteer tutors provide free one-on-one tutoring for motivated adult learners across Sheboygan County. Staff train caring community volunteers to provide tutoring using student-centered methods that earn results.
