Overview

Family Resource Center's Parents as Teachers (PAT) program surveyed participating families using our Annual Satisfaction Survey. The survey helps us understand families' experiences, measure program impact, and identify opportunities to continue strengthening services for the families we serve.

Growing Confident Parents



- 94% feel more confident in their parenting
- 97% better understand their child's development
- 94% feel equipped with tools to help their child thrive

Support that matters



- 97% say their parent educator helps them reach their goals
- 91% are connected to playgroups, events, and other families
- 100% feel ASQ child developmental screening results are shared clearly and understandably

Turning Feedback into Action



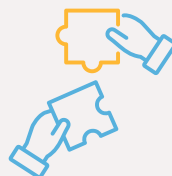
- Based on survey feedback about class timing, we will encourage parents to check social media events regularly and, whenever possible, we'll more actively share partnering agencies' classes to expand opportunities for families to connect in ways that fit their schedules.
- Based on parent feedback, we plan to update ASQ screening frequency to better align with family preferences while maintaining program guidelines.

Stronger Parent -Child connections



- 73% are reading or singing more with their child
- Families are using a variety of strategies to support development, including:
 - 82% intentional play
 - 79% involving children in daily routines
 - 64% creating consistent routines

Building Trust



- 97% would recommend Parents as Teachers to another family
- 70% of parents valued gaining emotional support, validation, and reassurance in their parenting, learning about their child's development, and receiving practical ideas for play and everyday parenting strategies

Families shared that the program not only helps them understand their child's development, but also provides reassurance, connection, and confidence as they navigate parenting.
